### Senior Signing Day Highlights

Rain showers could not wash out the excitement of Senior Signing Day (SSD) this past Sunday, May 23 at Rice Stadium! We celebrated 1,456 seniors in the Class of 2021, of whom over 90% are first-generation college-bound. The Class of 2021 submitted 13,171 applications and earned 6,794 acceptances! They earned millions and millions of dollars in scholarships, and 15 received the prestigious DREAM U.S. Scholarship. Some of the seniors have chosen to serve our country in the armed forces (and we're deeply grateful for the path of service they have chosen) and others have chosen to pursue a course other than college. Regardless of their path, they will always be part of the YES Prep family, and we'll always be proud of them. When the Class of 2021 goes to college this fall, there will be close to 9,000 YES Prep alumni who have earned or are actively pursuing their college degrees.

YES Prep seniors, Class of 2021, we were proud to celebrate your post-high school plans. Not only are you about two weeks away from graduating, but you will do so during an incredibly challenging year. We know that some of you have been looking forward to your senior year for as long as you can remember. Your families, friends and teachers have been rooting for you along the way, and this year especially we have never believed in you more and are endlessly impressed by the accomplishments of the Class of 2021 amidst the pandemic. ### YES Prep Graduation Ticketing and Livestream Update

With Senior Signing Day this past weekend, like many of you we are now looking forward to Graduation **on June 4-6, 2021**. As previously communicated, all graduation ceremonies will only allow for limited guests for



each graduate. Each graduate is allowed a ticket for two guests. Lap children do not count as a ticket towards the guest count. Seniors are receiving information about reserving tickets for their guests in their Senior Seminar course.

Family members who are not able to attend in person are able to watch the ceremonies live. Each ceremony's live stream will be broadcast on YES Prep's YouTube and Facebook Channels. Links to the YouTube and Facebook Streams can be found on the [Graduation Webpage](#).

**Updated Mask Policy for Graduation Ceremonies**

For those attending graduation ceremonies in person, per Governor Abbott's Executive Order last week regarding masks, masks will not be required at the Bayou City Event Center for Graduation. However, out of an abundance of caution for the safety of students, staff and families in attendance, we continue to strongly encourage their use especially by those not fully vaccinated and welcome students and their guests to wear them at the event.

**Mask Policy Update**

As a reminder, the Governor and the TEA will lift the mandatory mask requirement for schools after June 4. YES Prep is bound by this order and faces penalties if we are out of compliance. Our revised policy will be that the use of face coverings is strongly recommended but is optional in accordance with Executive Order GA-36 as issued by the Governor of Texas. This policy will come into effect after June 4 and will be revised as needed on July 2. While in the future masks will not be required on campuses in accordance with the latest state mandate, out of an abundance of caution for the safety of students, staff and their families, we continue to encourage their use.

Our health partner, Legacy Community Health, has been offering COVID-19 vaccines to eligible staff, students (note: the vast majority of our students are now eligible) and their families since March 8, 2021, and we expect many more will receive it in the coming weeks. ## Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT)

Enrolled students (up to 21 years of age) in families that temporarily lost access to free or reduced-price school meals for the 2020–2021 school year due to the COVID-19 pandemic may be eligible to receive Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT). P-EBT benefits can be used to buy food from any retailer that accepts the Lone Star Card.

The application for P-EBT will open June 2, 2021. Go to [yourtexasbenefits.com/Learn/PEBT](https://yourtexasbenefits.com/Learn/PEBT) to apply. The application link is case-sensitive. The deadline to apply is Aug. 13, 2021.

### Who Needs to Apply?

- A parent/guardian must apply if eligible child is:
  - Enrolled in K-12 and NOT part of a family who received SNAP benefits for at least one month between August 2020 and June 2021.
  - Born on or before Aug. 1, 2014 and is part of a family who received SNAP benefits for the first time during the 2020–2021 school year in May or June 2021.
- A parent/guardian DOES NOT have to apply if eligible child is:
  - Born on or before Aug. 1, 2014 and is part of a family who received SNAP benefits for at least one month between August 2020 and April 2021.
  - Born after Aug. 1, 2014 and is part of a family who received SNAP benefits for at least one month between October 2020 and June 2021.

## Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER III)

As a reminder, YES Prep Public Schools is eligible for the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER III). The ARP ESSER III grant will be used to address learning loss, underserved students, identify and provided homeless children and youth with services, and support additional public education needs. Our first annual Family-School Relationships Survey results are in from the Panorama Education Team! We scored at the 80<sup>th</sup> percentile in the 3 categories where there is national comparison data: Barriers to Engagement, School Climate, and School Fit. We will leverage those strengths as we work to address areas of focus that were identified. In terms of your **campus family survey results**, the Family Engagement Ambassadors (staff) and Family Fellows (parents) will be conducting a data dive and proposing a plan of action to campus Principals.
